

What Can I Donate?

We can accept most household furniture and goods as long as they are **under 6 feet in height and not stained, torn, or otherwise dirty.**

A furniture item is required for pickup, what we consider a furniture item is marked with * .

Bedroom

- Mattresses*
- Box Springs*
- Bed Frames (only if a mattress or box spring is also being donated)
- Dressers*
- Nightstands*
- Bedding
 - Pillows
 - Sheets
 - Blankets

Bedroom Items We Do Not Accept

- Novelty/Specialty Beds- Wall/murphy beds, day beds, trundles, poster beds, bunk beds, loft beds, futons, beds with connected/built-in storage, etc.
- Novelty/Specialty Mattresses- Water beds, mattress pads/toppers, medical beds, sleep number beds or other moving mattresses
- Headboards / Footboards / Frames if not accompanied by a mattress or box spring and/or if they do not have all original pieces for reassembly.

Kitchen & Dining

- Kitchen and Dining Tables (no glass tops)*
- Chairs*
- Bar Stools*
- Credenzas*
- Rolling carts, etc.
- Countertop Appliances (Toasters, Coffee Pots, Crock Pots, etc)
- Kitchen Goods
 - Table Linens
 - Glassware
 - Dishes
 - Silverware
 - Pots and Pans
 - Bakeware

Kitchen & Dining Items We Do Not Accept

- Fine China
- Alcohol-related glassware
- Glass top dining tables
- China cabinets, hutches, corner cabinets, curio cabinets, etc.
- Bars

Living Room

- Sofas / Love Seats*
- Arm Chairs*
- Side and Coffee Tables (no glass tops)*
- Select TV Stands (No Entertainment Centers)*
- Bookcases*
- Storage Cabinets*
- Wall Art, Mirrors
- Ottomans
- Lamps
- Curtains

Living Room Items We Do Not Accept

- Sleeper sofas, futons
- Extremely heavy reclining sofas
- Rugs
- Entertainment centers, armoires
- Glass tables
- Patio or Sunroom furniture

Other Items

- Wall Art
- Mirrors
- Home Decor
- Photo Frames
- TVs (Flatscreens only)
- Throw Pillows
- Storage Bins

Other Items We Do Not Accept

- House fixtures- wall cabinets, light fixtures, window treatments, etc.
- Large appliances/electronics- washers, dryers, refrigerators, stoves, stereo equipment, portable air conditioners, vacuums
- Recreation tables (i.e., ping-pong, poker, or pool tables)
- Knick-knacks
- Pianos and other musical instruments
- Bicycles
- Exercise equipment
- Medical Equipment
- Baby items and furniture such as cribs or changing tables (due to constantly changing safety standards)
- Office furniture including desks, file cabinets, rolling chairs, etc.
